Hope - Sending Hope. We curate and send care packages to survivors and caregivers each imbued with prayers and encouraging words. We send and donate water bottles to hospitals all over our region. Hope in the journey is essential.



Outreach- Outreach for patients and families. Holiday hope- providing gifts and needs for families with a parent in active treatment, scholarships for kids who have a parent with cancer, family photography, respite vacations. Radiant Hope offers a special and unique opportunity for the community to support those experiencing cancer. We host packing parties all over for businesses, sports teams, and other groups to pack our boxes, support a family for holiday hope, and other initiatives.



Partnerships- We establish and maintain partnerships and collaboration with hospitals, cancer treatment centers, oncology offices, and other organizations serving the cancer population. We work directly with social workers and patients to provide non-medical support to those in their cancer diagnosis. Collaborative efforts can enhance outreach efforts and reach a broader audience, and maximize resources.



Education and Empowerment - We have support groups, peer support, and educational workshops. These help education for prevention, early detection, treatment options, and other supportive care services. This empowers individuals with knowledge and resources to motivate their cancer journey.







On March 20, 2023, I received the news that I had Stage II Non-Small Cell Lung Cancer. I started chemo in June 2023. I was scheduled for surgery to remove the tumor that October. In surgery we received unexpected news. My diagnosis was adjusted to Stage IV and we resumed chemo in November with a more aggressive treatment plan. During the following five months, I was feeling pretty sick and had moments I questioned if I was going to make it, not only physically but emotionally as well. Professionally, I'm a Life Coach and work with my clients all the time regarding mental health issues. By nature, I'm pretty perky and positive, and it was all I could do to keep myself mentally stable during that time. I found that, with cancer, attitude makes all the difference, and my ship was sinking slowly but surely. Sometime during my "oh-cancers-not-that-bad" Summer season, I had received a box in the mail from Radiant Hope. I felt like I had been kissed and hugged and embraced with HOPE. The box held all sorts of practical treasures but the thing that caught my eye was a devotional called "50 Days of Hope" by Lynn Eib. It was a lifeline! After receiving the box, I decided to visit Radiant Hope's main office to see who they were and what they were all about. I fell in love with the organization and didn't feel so lonely in my journey, as many of the girls had personal experiences with cancer.



In a world where many people didn't understand the impact that cancer has on a family, I felt like I had found my tribe. During my more aggressive 7 ½ hr. chemo treatments, I had friends and family come in and sit with me on infusion days to help keep my spirits up and pass the time quickly. I reached out to Joanna Dennstaedt, the Executive Director of Radiant Hope, to come sit with me one afternoon. I was amazed at how willing and generous she was to make room in her schedule for me. While she was with me, she asked how Radiant Hope would be able to help me specifically. I said that I could use a support group, and she said she would make it happen! True to her word, Radiant Refuge was born. It has made a significant difference in my life, and it's one of the highlights of my month. These days, I no longer have chemotherapy, but I have a mixed infusion of monoclonal antibodies and immunotherapy. I've returned to my perky, bubbly self. I'm thankful that I no longer think about dying, but get to focus on living my best life ever. I'm so grateful that I'm well enough now to be a cheerleader and advocate for Radiant Hope. They truly are the tangible love of Jesus in action.

My name is Sara and I believe in the mission of Radiant Hope. I am a family medicine P.A. and therefore a helper by nature. Radiant Hope is right here in our little town of Dillsburg and when I heard about it, I knew I wanted to be a part of it! 1 Peter 4:10 says "As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another as good stewards of God's varied grace."

In 2021, our family bought a place in the Poconos on the Wallenpaupack Creek. Because we lead a busy life with 3 kids, we knew there was a lot of time the cabin would sit vacant and we wanted to do something meaningful with it. We decided to work with Radiant Hope to provide free respite stays for families who desperately needed the time to get away and rest. It has been such a blessing working with these families.

Back in 2020, I quit working during COVID because of the demands of my job and the inability to balance work and family life. This was a way that I could indirectly help people with cancer, who are in the fight of their lives. This has been such a humbling experience and I've enjoyed getting other people aware and involved with this organization.
